Conferences are an important time to connect and build the home/school partnership.

Olweus Bullying Prevention Program is used at Deephaven throughout the school year. Weekly lessons are taught to each of our classrooms. You can learn more about our approach to bullying prevention by reading the letter attached to this week's Winds (included below).

What Is Bullying? The definition of bullying is when someone repeatedly and on purpose says or does mean or hurtful things to another person who has a hard time defending himself or herself. Bullying can take many

forms, such as hitting, verbal harassment, not letting someone be part of the group, or sending unwanted messages on a cell phone or over the Internet.

Bullying does not include single incidents that result in discipline and are resolved. There is also "friendship friction" when students are having difficulty getting along with each other and the conditions do not meet the criteria for bullying.

Deephaven uses Responsive Classroom as a way of working with students. What is Responsive Classroom? It is a student-centered, social and emotional approach to teaching and discipline. This research-based approach helps create a safe, joyful, and engaging classroom where students can learn.

OLWEUS BULLYING PREVENTION

This week in our Olweus classroom meetings we will match our school rules about bullying to pretend situations. Family discussion item: Imagine that you saw two friends telling your other friend that she couldn't play. What school rule does this match with? What would you do? Our Olweus rule is that we will try to include others who are left out.

DID YOU KNOW?

Headphones It is important for students to have headphones for educational use. Personal sets of headphones will minimize the spread of germs. Students will keep their headphones/earbuds in the classroom. There are two options for providing headphones for your child:

- Send a pair from home. Many students have a preference for a particular style. Sending them from home will ensure they have what works best for them.
- Purchase a pair from school (pictured above). Use this link for purchasing information.

President's Volunteer Service Award/AmeriCorps - DEADLINE EXTENDED

If your child volunteers through school, a faith community, nonprofit, or in your neighborhood, they might be eligible for the President's Volunteer Service Award. Students track their service hours between Sept. 1, 2022 - Aug. 31, 2023. Awardees can be as young as 5, and the hours required are based on age. Awards will be presented at the Celebration of Service, scheduled for November 6, 2023.

The application deadline has been extended to Sept. 20, 2023.
