You will be receiving an email on Tuesday, February 15 at 5 p.m. with instructions on how to sign conferences. Please let your child's teacher know if you have questions.

**February 18 – No in-person school.** Teachers will provide limited synchronous instruction along with asynchronous instruction on Friday, February 18. Students will work at home from 8:00-2:40 p.m. Your child's teacher will provide you with a schedule for the day closer to February 18. Childcare is available to families who need it. Please contact the office if you need childcare and did not complete the registration form.

**Attendance** – During wintery weather we delay taking attendance until 8:10 a.m. on days when traffic is moving more slowly.

As we move toward better weather, we want to let you know it is important to have your child at school each day between 7:50 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. After 8:00 a.m. your child is late and will be marked tardy. To excuse a tardy, you must come into school and sign your child in when they arrive.
