How Do I Become An Author?

#1 WRITE and EDIT your story! You have one to tell. Fact or fiction. Be creative and go on a crazy mind adventure. Create interesting characters or step into a fantasy. Unravel a mystery. Tell us about a great vacation or special event. Explore the life of a person you admire. Create a collection of poems.

Please have your parent <u>or</u> teacher <u>or</u> family member <u>or</u> friend read your story and provide you with some helpful ways to improve your story. EDIT again. Make it the best you can!

Note: Maximum of 2 stories per month, please.

After each story submission, all writer's will be invited to attend the Author's Breakfast. You will receive your published story, a Certificate of Recognition from Principal DeCorsey and a treat. You will have time to share your story with your fellow authors and/or sometimes you will meet a Guest Author.

#3 ADD any illustrations to your book and cover page, as long as they are within the required margins (see "formatting your book").
